

ERASMUS+ MOBILITY PROGRAMME 2024/2025



Organisation

Exchange students start their *Erasmus mobility programme* with a compulsory theoretical module and continue with clinical placement.

The main objective is to offer all exchange students a common start and an opportunity for social, international and interprofessional networking from the beginning of the exchange period.

After the compulsory module, students continue with clinical placement based on their own professional interests.

Duration

The Erasmus mobility programme will take place in the spring semester: **27 January – 25 April 2025.**

Application deadline

15 November 2024. Applicants will be notified of the admission decision by the end of November.

Application Procedure

✓ <u>STEP 1:</u> The home university nominates the

selected students to the Office of International Relations at the University of Ljubljana (intern.office@uni-lj.si).

STEP 2: Nominated students submit an online application.

STEP 3: After approval by the host university, students receive an admission letter and an information package about living and studying in Ljubljana.

Language Requirements

Expected English proficiency refers to level B2 on the CEFR scale of European Language Portfolio Levels.

Obligatory Vaccination

Vaccination against measles and hepatitis B is compulsory for all incoming students.

Subject content:

Linguistic and cultural diversity awareness in health care (3 ECTS)

Critical Literature Analysis for an Evidence-Based Practice in Health Care (3 ECTS)

Research questions in health care sciences. Typology of literature reviews (scoping review, systematic review, meta-analysis, qualitative systematic review). Conducting literature searches in appropriate scientific databases according to the research question. Critical analysis of written sources. Syntesis of evidence and application to clinical practice. Substantiating clinical decisions using scientific literature.

Preventing musculoskeletal problems of health professionals (3 ECTS)

Overview of most common injuries of health professionals. Risk factors for developing musculoskeletal injuries of health professionals. European guidelines for lifting and carrying heavy objects. Guidelines for safety when lifting and transferring patients. Biomechanics of lifting. Body mechanics during lifting. Use of specific devices for lifting and transfer of patients.
