

# Simone Collio



Former Italian professional sprinter with 36 participations with the national team, 10 Italian titles won and 3 Olympic participations.

Today he is a specialist in the field of sport physiotherapy with a Physiotherapy degree achieved in 2011, sprint coach and FIDAL instructor.

He made the fourth Italian performance ever in the 100 meters and won the silver medal at the 2010 European Championships in Barcelona with the 4×100 meters relay that broke the historic Italian record in specialties after 27 years, setting it at 38"17.

He has been the head of the team of physiotherapists of the Bulgarian national athletics team since 2013 with which he has participated in several European and world events, including World Athletics Championships in Doha 2019, Tokyo 2021 Olympic Games and the last World Athletics Championships in Eugene 2022.

Since 2016, he has been an essential member of the Wintecare team of trainers and therapists and from 2022 he became the coordinator of Wintecare Performance Division.
