CURRICULUM ADAPTATIONS FOR SPECIAL STATUS STUDENTS

Depending on the requested status and submitted documentation, you may obtain the following curriculum benefits:

• reduction of compulsory presence and/or a partly excused absence in joint study obligations, **approved with the courses' professor**;

• taking the exam outside examination timetable and in a customized manner (e.g. oral exam instead of written);

• up to two supplementary examination dates and up to two supplementary colloquium dates for each study course in a given academic year;

• a deferred deadline for presenting the seminar work and for taking the colloquium and exam in the event of participating in competitions at home or abroad;

• enrollment in a subsequent year or an extended student status for up to one year under special conditions defined in the university statute.

HOW TO OBTAIN THE STATUS?

You must apply for a special status when enrolling in college and after the expiration of a special status. In the event that special circumstances arise during the academic year, you can apply later.

Do not forget along with the application, it is necessary to submit the required evidence of categorization of the Olympic Committee of Slovenia – Association of Sports Federations (OCS), a proof of membership issued by an individual national or international association or Association of Fine Arts Societies, an order of the National Education Institute of Slovenia.

Students with special needs

Status may be obtained in the case of:

- partial or complete loss of vision,
- partial or complete loss of hearing,
- speech-language problems, (communication problems),
- motor-function disturbances,
- long-term or chronic diseases,
- deficits in individual areas of learning,
- emotional and behavioral disorders (e.g. psychological problems).

Student athletes

Student - athletes are students who, in addition to their studies, competitively take part in sports discipline and achieve recognized sports achievements important in the national and international environments.

You can obtain a status if:

- you are a categorized sports athlete,
- you are appointed as a coach of a national team or an individual-categorized athlete.

Who is a categorized athlete?

A categorized athlete is is an athlete who, on the basis of the Olympic Committee of Slovenia - Association of Sports Associations, The Paralympic Committee of Slovenia, has achieved one of the following titles:

- a world class athlete,
- an international class athlete,
- a prospective student,
- national class athlete.

Student cultural workers

You can obtain a status if:

- you are a member of a national or international association or association of arts societies,
- you have a certificate of the status of a cultural worker,
- you have publicly recognized works of art.
